Headlining the 2011 [Indianapolis Air Show](#) at Mt. Comfort Airport, sponsored by Tom Wood Automotive Group, will be the [U.S. Navy's Blue Angels](#). One of the most sought-after jet teams in the world, the Blue Angels will showcase the skills possessed by these amazing naval aviators, flying F-18 Hornets in thrilling aerial routines.

Along with the Blue Angels, numerous military and civilian performers will be demonstrating outstanding feats [in the sky](#). Jacquie Warda, a female pilot who launched into the air show circuit at the age of 50, will be showing off her flair for aerobatics, as well as conducting seminars on aerobatic flying. The list of additional aerial performers includes: the Viper West F-16 Demonstration Team, Grayout Aerosports' Billy Werth, Red Eagle Air Sports, the FM-2 "Wildcat," the 4FU "Corsair," and the Wright B Flyer, which will take you back to the age of the Wright Brothers.

[On the ground](#), air show-goers can check out the BT-13 Valiant, L-5 Sentinel, PT-26 Cornell, P-51D Mustang, the Civil Air Patrol, and the KC-135R Cockpit Mockup and Boom Simulator, just to name a few.

The Tom Wood Automotive Group 2011 Indianapolis Air Show kicks off with “Media Day” on Friday, May 13. Tickets for Media Day are \$10 for adults and \$5 for kids, and can only be purchased online at www.indyairshow.com or at the Indianapolis Air Show office at Mt. Comfort Airport.
